Hospitality Room and Alcohol Policy

Isleta Hotel

The Isleta Hotel Policy is that Hospitality Rooms will not be allowed!!!!

But, If they don't know you have the Liquor or beer in your room, it's allowed. Therefore, <u>Discretion and privacy</u> will be primary factor in this Policy.

- 1. Alcohol and beer beverages are allowed in the privacy of all sleeping rooms for your own consumption.
 - All drinks must be consumed in the privacy of these rooms. NO Alcohol will be allowed outside of rooms. NO Alcohol will be allowed in the hallways at any time.
- 2. Liquor will be brought into the hotel inside luggage or other unmarked boxes.
- 3. <u>Discretion</u> is key. If the hotel personnel don't see these items they won't ask. But, if they see any liquor or beer products, they <u>Will Not</u> Let You Bring It into the hotel.
- 4. Beer can be brought into the hotel inside Ice chests or unmarked boxes or containers.
 - The hotel personnel should not see any Alcohol products entering the hotel. They will not check luggage, Ice chests or unmarked boxes/containers.
- 5. If some lodges would like to share a Junior Suite on the 5th floor if available you can do so. There are adjoining rooms to the suite for expanding to give a little more room.
- 6. Ice will be available through room service. If Ice is needed, you can order it and have the ice delivered to an adjoining sleeping room, not the Suites. If liquor is seen by the staff, it will be reported to management. So use common since and discretion when ordering.
- 7. Please bring your own trash bags. All trash and empty liquor bottles and beer should be placed in the bag and tied closed when full and placed outside of room for pickup from hotel staff.
- 8. No Signs will be allowed to be posted outside of any rooms unless posted by NMEA Convention Committee or Hotel Staff.
- RVs at Lake area: Alcohol will be allowed but confined to your RV site.
 Again, discretion is key, not to embarrass the Association or the Organization.

10. IF ANY PART OF THESE POLICIES ARE VIOLATED, YOU WILL BE ASKED/TOLD TO LEAVE THE HOTEL!!!! So, please I ask for your full cooperation with these instructions. They are very easy to follow.
